## Axpo to purchase energy from DIF Capital Partners' wind farms in Poland

**Axpo Polska has signed a power purchase agreement (PPA) for the offtake of energy from six wind farms in Poland owned by DIF Capital Partners, it was announced today. With a total installed capacity of 171 MW, the facilities will produce an estimated 500 GWh of green electricity a year. The PPA provides for spot market settlements, purchase of guarantees of origin, and the provision of balancing services.**

Under the partnership with DIF Capital Partners, a Netherlands-based infrastructure fund manager, Axpo Polska will offtake energy from all DIF Capital Partners' wind farms in Poland. The contract provides for spot market the settlements, the purchase of guarantees of origin, and the provision of balancing services. Negotiations between the parties were supported on Axpo's behalf by Konrad Kosicki, Partner and Head of the Energy and Natural Resources Practice at Greenberg Traurig Poland.

Axpo Polska Head of Institutional Clients, Western Europe & Eastern Europe, Mateusz Marczewski, said: "Poland boasts significant onshore wind energy potential, and we are pleased to see another investor interested in developing activities in this field within the Polish market. I appreciate that DIF Capital Partners have decided to trust our knowledge and international experience."
